Among the items that are Acceptable for donations are:

- Battery candles
- Bookends
- Cookware
- Games
- Housewares
- Kitchen Ware
- Linens
- Placemats
- DVD's only (no players)
- Picnic items
- Puzzles
- Small glass candy dishes
- Small electronic tools
- Small children's toys
- Small sports equipment
- Small manual tools
- Small vases
- Unused candles
- Matched sets of dinner or wine glasses (4 piece or less)
- Up-to-date small kitchen equipment

The following items are Unacceptable:

- CD players and CD's
- Clothing items or purses and wallets
- Christmas trees
- Computers and keyboards
- Cookie or popcorn tins
- Everyday coffee mugs
- Commemorative or promotional mugs, glasses or water bottles
- Health and beauty aids
- Pens/pencils or other office supplies
- Photo albums/scrap books
- Video players or tapes
- Stuffed animals
- Televisions

- Children's toys with miniature pieces
- Large frames, mirrors, paintings, photos, pictures or vases
- Large appliances, furniture or vacuum cleaners or floor cleaners
- Large children's toys or ride-on toys
