Enjoy an evening of tiny art, a silent auction, and tasty treats. The Young Librarians will also be here selling their handmade crafts.

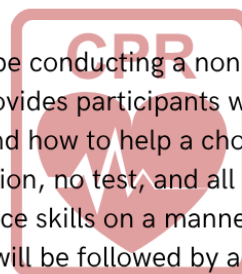
